## Opportunities

- Cooperation with excellent junior and senior researchers in a motivating environment
- Further establishment of an international interdisciplinary educational research network of researchers working at Leibniz Institutes and universities throughout Europe
- An outstanding setting for developing new and innovative research ideas in the field of interdisciplinary educational research, as well as support for post-College research proposals
- Several workshops with senior researchers from the participating institutes and universities, as well as with international guests
- Interdisciplinary activities developed independently by the young researchers and carried out in cooperation with colleagues from other disciplines within the College (“Micro Groups” – e.g. funding for English language copy editing for project related journal articles, funding for required data, student assistants, travel costs)
- Funding for research stays at one of the participating Leibniz institutes of 1-10 months, based on a competitive grant process
- Grants for research stays abroad of one to two months (up to €2,300)
- Funding for organizing interdisciplinary workshops based on own interests
- Funding for participating in interdisciplinary conferences or conferences or “other” disciplines on educational research
- Funding for participating in the interdisciplinary conferences for young scholars of the Leibniz Network in Educational Research (LERN). Teaching at or participating in two method College summer schools for Master’s students
- Participating in CIDER workshops on public science and on professional skills
- Mentoring, if desired, by one of the participating senior scientists or fellows of the first cohort

## Expectations

- Continuous and active participation in College activities and workshops (see page 2 of this document)
- Collaboration in (at least) one of the Micro Groups on College research topics
- Publication of scientific articles on College research topics
- Two transfer- and public science publications and activities during the fellowship
- Strong interest in using the following datasets: the German National Educational Panel Study (NEPS), the German Socio-Economic Panel (SOEP), or the OECD Program for the International Assessment of Adult Competencies (PIAAC). Projects may also use comparable international datasets.
